**In order for an protest to be valid it must be submitted in accordance to Rules 82, 83,84,87,88, whichever is appropriate. A Club may appeal the decision of the Executive/ Disciplinary Committee to the Leinster Football Association and afterwards to the Football Association of Ireland, in accordance to Rule 85. All protests/appeals and/or objections relating to Cup competitions organised by the LFA or the FAI must be directed to the respective Associations in Dublin. Stupid and or unnecessary appeals to these organisations will result in the Club receiving a substantial fine.**

Yellow Card suspensions issued by the League: Appeals/ Protests must be sent to the LFA and not to the Carlow League
